## **Rationale**

The purpose of this traditional Course which has been held annually since 1973 and involves the main Italian experts in the organisation, is the study of coagulation disorders (haemorrhagic and thrombotic). As always, the talks on the first and second day will cover various topics regarding these disorders in the physiopathology, diagnostic and clinical sectors that have recently witnessed great progress. As usual, the afternoon of the first day will focus on a particularly relevant and binding issue for participants and this year the topic addressed will be the choice of laboratory tests necessary for confirming or ruling out a haemorrhagic disorder. In addition, there will be a critical discussion on whether laboratory tests are able to reduce the thrombotic risk both in indigent individuals and those who have already had clinical manifestations and run the risk of relapses.
