



Dear Colleagues,

Heart Failure is considered as the novel pandemy, particularly among those older than 65 years of age, and nowadays more than 23 millions of people are burdened by this condition worldwide.

However, several advances have been made in the last decades in the filed of Heart Failure, Cardiomyopathies and Pericardial Disease, significantly improving survival of patients.

This meeting, thanks to lecturers, speakers and chairpersons from world class institutes, will be focused on the most updated novelties on Heart Failure, on characterization and prognostic stratification of Cardiomyopathies and on Pericardial Disease paying special attention to the multidisciplinary approach ranging from clinicians to molecular cardiologist and to bioengineers.
